On April 16-19, the National Grid Corporation of the Philippines raised the alarm that power supply for the Luzon grid was insufficient to meet consumer demands and rotating power outages may be imminent.

Fortunately, power interruptions were reduced with the help of the Department of Energy's Interruptible Load Program (ILP).

Businesses voluntarily shut down non-essential equipment and operations, shifted to generators, and lessened their electricity usage.

Our sincerest appreciation goes out to all our ILP partners.
Commitment reached a peak of 345MW*, which was enough to supply the energy needs of around 1.9M* households, sparing them from power outages on these days.
