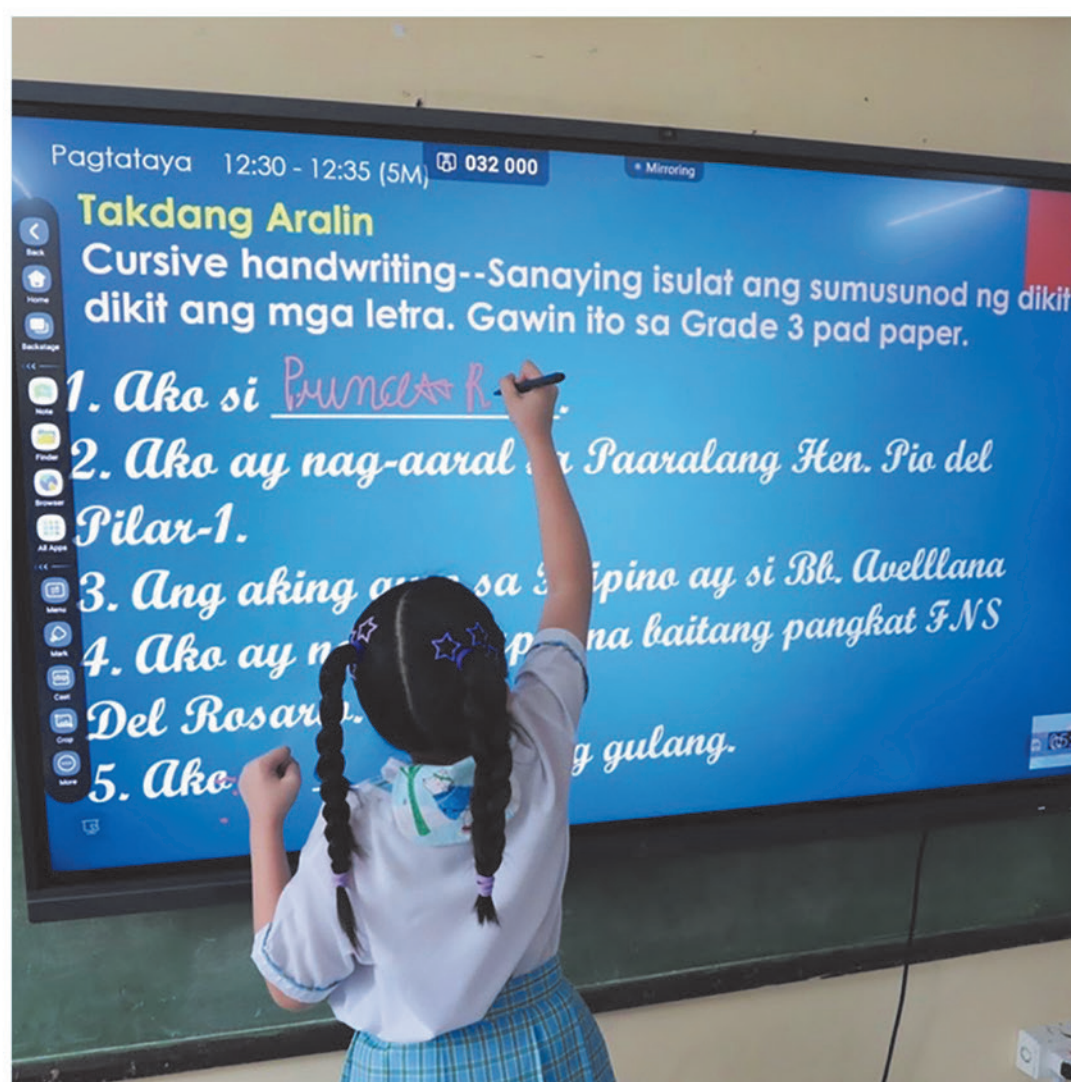
The city government's transparent and firm financial management is recognized by the Commission on Audit and other institutions.
