

FACT CHECK: Transmission Charges



✓ **Only 3.26% of your total power bill goes to NGCP!**

✓ **NGCP does not earn from Ancillary Services (AS) charges!**

NGCP collects AS, but this **goes entirely to generation companies providing AS**. Only **33.10%** of the total transmission charges goes to NGCP!

✓ **PH transmission charges are one of the lowest compared to other countries!**

* Transmission charges include wheeling rates, for the primary service of delivering power, and ancillary services charge, which are pass-through costs for power supplied by AS providers to stabilize the grid during supply-demand imbalances.
